Healing of Memories workshops were designed to respond to emotional, psychological, and spiritual wounds inflicted by war, human rights abuses, and other traumatic circumstances. They provide a safe place for participants, including religious leaders, to embark on a transformative journey of exploring personal histories, finding insight, and cultivating empathy for themselves and others.
